

**Luke 6:39-9:27****Thursday, March 25 – Luke 6:39-7:10**

1. Distinguish between the right kind of judging and the wrong kind of judging.

**Friday, March 26 – Luke 7:11-35**

2. How might the centurion's attitude of humility and yet also confidence be applied to the following situations: marital problems, financial woes, despair or depression, sinful habits, personality conflicts, fear of witnessing to others?

Verse 28 - *"The one who is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he."* Jesus was not saying that John was not in the kingdom of God. He was only comparing John's human abilities and role with the blessings of being a member of God's kingdom. The least member of God's kingdom has more blessings than even John had as a richly blessed human being.

Verse 32 - *"They are like children."* Jesus characterizes the fickleness of his countrymen. They permitted neither John's message of repentance and faith (the dirge) to affect them nor Jesus' message of joy in forgiveness (the flute) to lead them away from their smug work-righteousness.

**Saturday, March 27 – Luke 7:36-8:3**

3. Some people say that if you forgive someone, you will only make the person sin more. Evaluate that statement.

**Sunday, March 28 – Luke 8:4-21**

4. Verse 3 - *"Joanna the wife of Cuza, the manager of Herod's household"*—It is interesting to speculate about how the wife of such a prominent person might become a follower of Jesus. The Jewish historian Josephus says that it was not unusual for women to support religious leaders (like Pharisees and rabbis) with their money.

Verse 8 - *"He who has ears to hear, let him hear."* This parable begins and ends with strong admonitions to pay attention to it.

5. Think of some excuses you have used not to go to church or Bible study or to read God's Word. How does the warning Jesus gives in verse 18 apply to you
